Ripens too slowly, lacks flavor and sweetness. Info. on this variety from Sanders, Figs in Containers, Fruit Gardeners, California Rare Fruit Growers, Vol. 23, No.6, December 1991: Medium-to-large, thin-skinned, dark reddish-brown fruit. Medium-open eye. Very sweet, white-to-amber flesh. Ad apt to cool, short summers, coastal areas. Has poor production and less flavor in hot climates.
