Per R. Morgan, 2/18/1986: "Fruit smallish or medium-size, with thin green skin, very pale flesh, good distinctive flavor though not super sweet. Ripe in July (rarely with small fall crop as well). Tree not very large. Original tree was probably here [Soquel, CA] when my grandfather bought the place in 1920. I have only seen one other of this variety (also in Soquel), and I've long been curious what its name and origin might have been."
