Info. on this variety from Watts, Figs in Coastal Southern California, Fruit Gardeners, California Rare Fruit Growers, Vol. 23, No. 6, December 1991: Medium, green skin, red pulp. Tough skin. Birds avoid it. Does not crack, shrivels when ripe. Good on coast. Info. on this variety from Sanders, Figs in Containers, Fruit Gardeners, California Rare Fruit Growers, Vol. 23, No.6, December 1991: Small-to-medium, thin-skinned, greenish-yellow fruit with strawberry-red flesh. Fine flavor. Fairly tight eye. Excellent fresh or dried. Heavy bearing, rather dwarf tree does well in pots.
