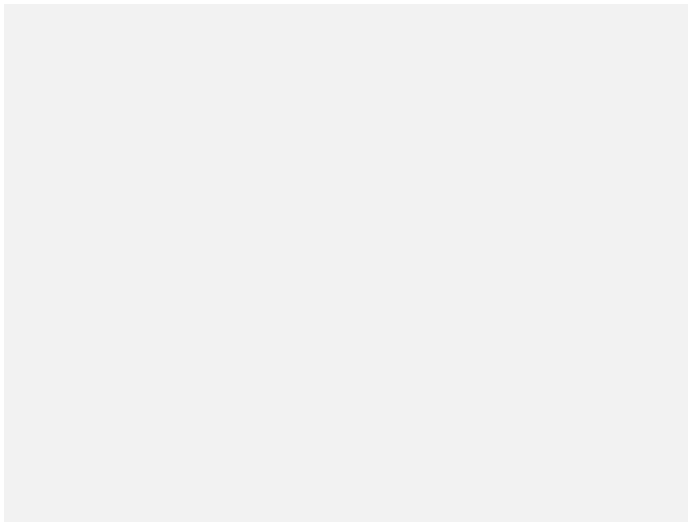


Fig Tree Cuttings
