Best suited for cooler West Coast growing areas, does not hold up in hot climates. Very late crop and can even ripen after first frosts. Upright grower that responds well to annual pruning. Grown in 4" x 9" grower pots. A slow grower and these trees are on the small side. One per customer, please.
