Figs are not only a sweet delicious summer treat, they are easy to grow and their beautiful foliage and form adds a tropical look to the garden. Green, bronze and mahogany colored fruit with juicy amber or white flesh ripens during hot summer months. Ripe fruit will be soft to the touch and they will wilt on the stem. Many of our varieties will produce a second crop of fruit in September, and all of the varieties we carry are self-fertile.

Fig trees are pest-free, adaptable to many climate and soil conditions and drought tolerant, once established. They can be pruned to stay small, espaliered onto a fence or hot wall, or allowed to sprawl.

Grows to 15-20', loves sun & heat, Hardy in Z7-9

BLACK SPANISH	Very sweet, dark mahogany-colored fruit. Reliable and productive for the PNW. Dwarf tree, well suited for container culture.
BROWN TURKEY	Medium to large fruit with brownish maroon skin and sweet, juicy, firm, meaty flesh. Excellent all-purpose. Ripens in September.
CONADRIA	A medium large fig with green skin with whitish pink flesh. Rich flavor. Good for drying and fresh eating. Two crops per year.
KING	Large green fruit with amber flesh, very good flavor and quality. Good fresh, canned or dried. Strong grower; heavy yielding. Ripens late July.
LATTARULA (Italian Honey)	Greenish yellow fruit with sweet, amber colored flesh. Good all-purpose. Well adapted to the PNW. May ripen two crops, once in July and once in September.
NEGRONNE	Small almost black fruits with dark red flesh. Good flavor fresh or dried. Extremely hardy, and good in containers. Ripens September.
OREGON PROLIFIC	Yellowish green skinned fruit with good flavor. Excellent quality fruit for fresh eating or canning. Well adapted to the Northwest. Heavy producer. Ripens in August.
PETER'S HONEY	Sicilian variety with light yellow-green skin and dark amber, sweet flesh. Excellent for fresh eating, drying or canning.
STELLA	Large sweet fruit with red flesh. One of the best for PNW.
TEXAS EVERBEARING	Medium to large, brownish mahogany to purple fruit. High quality, amber flesh. Excellent for fresh eating and preserves.
VERN'S BROWN TURKEY	Brown skinned fruit with sweet amber flesh. Excellent all-purpose. Reliable producer, two crops in most years. Ripens in July-Sept.
