The Garden is located in the skirt of a mountain of the Majorca Island to 5 km of the sea and occupies an extension of 6,874 m². It is formed by two different parts: to the left an orchard of orange trees with 4,823 m², distributed in eight terraces, that have been transformed into a garden of acclimatization of trees, shrubs and lianas from worldwide and to the right other portion of 2,051 m² of almost virgin mountain with the typical vegetation of the Tramuntana mountain range, including some endemic plants. The orchard counts with a system of irrigation by dripping and enjoys a microclimate something warmer than the rest of the Island, which allows to cultivate tropical and subtropical plants.
